
## On the agenda:

In the Platform for Transformative Change, we look for signs of fundamental change; in the way we relate to the world around us, in the way we interact with ecosystems, in the way we generate and use knowledge. **What can we learn** from each other, from nature and from projects that really want to do things differently? And **what can we do** to ensure that these developments will reinforce each other?



The platform is an initiative of VITO, from its participation in the **Horizon Europe project <u>SELINA</u>**. The aim of this project is to promote protection, restoration and sustainable use of ecosystems through broad knowledge sharing, and to pave the way for transformative change.

We are not starting from scratch. In shaping the community, we like to build

on the work of the <u>Belgian Ecosystems and Society community</u> (BEES). This community connects experts in the field of ecosystem services with each other and with international networks.

As a starting point for exchange, we are looking for 'Seeds of Change' - initiatives by governments, citizens and/or companies that (can) make a difference in practice. Where do we find them? And what characterises these initiatives?



In addition, we offer space to think together about the direction and design of the new platform. How can the platform **add value**? What should it then be about? And how do we proceed?
